Call for Tenders for provision of one consultant to provide support to the development of SASS-C system

SASS-C (Surveillance Analysis Support System for ATC Centre) is a software system for Surveillance Infrastructure Analysis operated by ANSP's and ATM industry, and maintained/developed by EUROCONTROL and its industrial partners.

SASS-C system is made of two main functions:

- Surveillance Infrastructure Performance PREDICTion,
- Surveillance Infrastructure Performance VERIFication,

The present tender action relates to the outsourcing, under the form of one time based contract for assistance service to support the development, implementation and support of SASS-C system.
